Professor Bright's research is included in leading US, Canadian and Australian textbooks and has been published in the world's leading peer-reviewed scientific journals.

He is the author of nine best-selling career development books that have been published in the US, UK, Australia, India, China, Italy, Denmark, Sweden, Vietnam, Japan, Korea, Romania and Russia. He has published over 210 peer reviewed psychological journal articles, books, book chapters, reports, tests and general psychological articles. Professor Bright writes a weekly column for *The Sydney Morning Herald* and *The Age* on Career Development called the Ladder.
