PLEASE NOTE:

1. The *Constitution and Election Regulations of The Australian National University Students' Association* require that:
 - (i) Nominations must be signed by two ordinary members of the Association (other than the candidate themselves). A nominator must not nominate more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled.
 - (ii) Only an ordinary member of the Association is eligible to vote for, or stand for election to, a representative position within the Association. The positions to be filled at the annual election are: President, Vice President, General Secretary, Treasurer, Social Officer, Education Officer, Sexuality Officer, Environment Officer, Women's Officer, Indigenous Officer, Disabilities Officer (held individually or jointly), International Students' Officer, 14 General Representative positions to the SRC, 2 College Representative positions to the CRC from each College of the University and 1 Editor of *Woroni* (who may be an individual or a group of individuals). Candidates for a position of College Representative must be enrolled in the relevant College (Note: the ANU College of Physical Sciences and the ANU College of Medicine, Biology and Environment shall together be considered one electorate for the purposes of the election and will elect 2 representatives in total). Candidates for the position of Sexuality Officer must be openly gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, intersex or queer identifying. Only people identifying as women shall vote or nominate for the position of Women's Officer as per sections 3.1.2 and 3.1.3 of the ANUSA Constitution. Only Indigenous students shall vote or nominate for the position of Indigenous Officer. Only students with a disability shall vote or nominate for the position of Disabilities Officer. Only international students shall vote or nominate for the position of International Students' Officer. An ordinary member of the Association is any person enrolled at the ANU as an undergraduate and who has not written to the General Secretary of the Association specifically stating that he or she does not wish to be a member of the Association (Note: under the ANUSA Constitution, the term 'undergraduate' excludes Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery students).
 - (iii) Nominations must contain a signed statement of the nominee's willingness to act in the position if elected.
 - (iv) Nominations must contain a signed undertaking by the nominee that he/she will abide by the *Election Regulations*.
 - (v) **All nominations should be placed in the locked ballot box provided in the Council and Boards Secretariat, between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on any week day during the period Monday 20 July 2009 to Wednesday 5 August 2009.** This office is located on the first floor of the Chancelry, Room 1.11. Candidates for the position of Sexuality Officer must sign and provide to the Returning Officer a statutory declaration indicating that they are openly gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, intersex or queer identifying.
2. The Returning Officer will maintain a Register of Ticket Names. Ticket registrations, signed by 5 or more ordinary members of the Association, will be accepted by the Returning Officer during the registration period. Only those ticket names that have been duly registered will appear on ballot papers. No person is entitled to apply for registration of a ticket name if that person has already applied for the registration of another ticket. Forms to register ticket names are available from the Council and Boards Secretariat, the office of the Association or on the Internet at http://info.anu.edu.au/OVC/Committees/090PP_Elections/ANUSA_Election/. **The period for ticket registrations will commence at 10.00am on Monday 20 July 2009 and cease at 4.00pm on Monday 3 August 2009.**
3. Candidates in the election may indicate to the Returning Officer the ticket with which they are running, or that they are running as an independent. Where a candidate indicates on the nomination form that she/he is running as a candidate endorsed by a registered ticket, the Returning Officer shall verify this endorsement if at least one of the nominators is a signatory to the application to register the ticket name or the Returning Officer receives notice of the endorsement from a signatory to the application to register the ticket name.
4. Nominations are not required to be made on this Form. A nomination will be valid so long as it meets all of the requirements as set out above.
5. The *Constitution and Election Regulations* of the Association are available from the Association's Office.
6. **Application to register electoral publications must be made to the Registrar of Publications, Council and Boards Secretariat.**
