PLEASE NOTE:

The following procedures have been determined in accordance with the Constitution, Regulations and By-Laws of the National Union of Students Inc, and where silent, the Constitution and Election Regulations of The Australian National University Students' Association.

1. The successful candidates will serve for a term from the commencement of the Annual State Conference immediately following their election until the commencement of the next Annual State Conference following their election.
2. Delegates to the meetings of National Conference of the National Union of Students Inc must be elected by and from, and must remain during their term, students represented by a Member Organisation or be full-time Office Bearers of a Member Organisation. No student may be elected as a Delegate to the National Conference by the students represented by a member Organisation, where that student has already been elected as a Delegate to the same National Conference by the students of another Member Organisation.
3. **The period for lodgement of nominations will commence at 10.00am on Monday 20 July 2009 and cease at 4.00 pm on Wednesday 5 August 2009.**
4. All nominations should be placed in the locked ballot box provided in the Council and Boards Secretariat, between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on any week day during the period in which nominations are open. This office is located on the first floor of the Chancery, Room 1.11.
5. All nomination forms must include the signature of the nominator, a seconder, and the nominee. Nomination forms are available from the Council and Boards Secretariat, from the office of the Association and on the internet at http://info.anu.edu.au/OVC/Committees/090PP_Elections/ANUSA_Election/.
6. Nominations are not required to be made on this Form. A nomination will be valid so long as it meets all of the requirements set out above.
7. The Returning Officer will maintain a Register of Ticket Names. **Ticket registrations, signed by 5 or more ordinary members of the Association, will be accepted by the Returning Officer during the period beginning at 10.00 am on Monday 20 July 2009 and ceasing at 4.00 pm on Monday 3 August 2009.** Only those ticket names that have been duly registered will appear on ballot papers. No person is entitled to apply for registration of a ticket name if that person has already applied for the registration of another ticket. Forms to register ticket names are available from the Council and Boards Secretariat, the office of the Association or on the Internet at http://info.anu.edu.au/OVC/Committees/090PP_Elections/ANUSA_Election/. Candidates in the election may indicate to the Returning Officer the ticket with which they are running, or that they are running as an independent. Where a candidate indicates on the nomination form that she/he is running as a candidate endorsed by a registered ticket, the Returning Officer shall verify this endorsement if at least one of the nominators is a signatory to the application to register the ticket name or the Returning Officer receives notice of the endorsement from a signatory to the application to register the ticket name.
8. The order of candidates on the voting paper will be determined on 10 August 2009 commencing at 9.30 am, in the Rudita Leverington Room, the Chancery. The order of candidates within a group endorsed by a registered ticket can be specified by that group if the request is received in writing by the Returning Officer before 10 August.
9. The Constitution and Regulations of the National Union of Students Inc, and of The Australian National University Students' Association, are available from the Association's Office.
10. **Application to register electoral publications must be made to the Registrar of Publications, Council and Boards Secretariat.**
