Kevin Lonsdale has a very impressive record of service to the wider University Community having served on some 15 committees, including the Vice-Chancellor's Appointment Committee, the University Finance Committee, the Senior Classifications Committee and the Buildings and Grounds Committee. He was recently a member of the University Council for four years.

Kevin Lonsdale has demonstrated the energy and drive to foresee and implement change. He is committed to the cause of sustainable development on campus and has played a key role in the building and refurbishment program at RSPHysSE. He has also been a great advocate for training and planning within the technical ranks.
